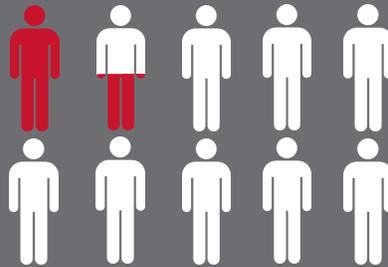
Mississippi has the **HIGHEST** rate of ischemic stroke in the Medicare population, according to the Centers for Disease Control- 11.1 hospitalizations PER 100 Medicare Beneficiaries

5th leading cause of death and a *leading* cause of disability in the state of Mississippi

4th In the nation for death related to immediate or longterm effects of stroke

83% of Ischemic strokes in Mississippi in 2015 were treatable, with an effective system of care

We Only **Treat** 15% of eligible patients with approved treatment for Large Vessel/Massive strokes
